Marks & Patches

Following on from the PPA Calculation thread I thought I should write to our members and describe what constitutes a Mark in a Cricket or 01 game and what qualifies for a CVDA Patch.

Cricket Games

During his/her games the player may score his/her darts that result in a “mark”. Each mark has a point’s value. These are currently deemed to be as follows:

	Cricket legs (Triple = t, Double =d single =s)	Value
5 Marks	(T+S+S or D+D+S or T+D)	1 point
6 Marks	(T+T or T+D+S or D+D+D)	3 points
7 Marks	(T+T+S or T+D+D)	5 points
8 Marks	(T+T+D)	7 points
9 Marks	(T+T+T)	10 points

*****Any 9 Mark hit will be qualified for a 9 Mark patch at the end of the season.*****

01 Games

5 Marks	95 – 113	(T+S+S or D+D+S or T+D)	1 point
6 Marks	114 – 132	(T+T or T+D+S or D+D+D)	3 points
7 Marks	133 – 151	(T+T+S or T+D+D)	5 points
8 Marks	152 – 164	(T+T+D)	7 points
9 Marks	165 – 180	(T+T+T)	10 points

*****ONLY the 180 shot is accepted as a qualified shot in the 01 game for a patch.*****

(i.e. A T19+T19+T19 = 171 does **NOT** qualify for a patch in any 01 games nor do any permutation of three triple shots except T20+T20+T20) (The player, will however, still be given 20 points towards their PPA ranking)
