

Membership Meeting May 8, 2013

Location: Sportsman

Jimmy Jordan called the meeting to order at 7:44pm

Jim welcomed everyone to the 2013 summer season membership meeting.

He thanked Sportsman for allowing us to have our meeting here.

Jim stated that a member from each team must sign for the packets at the end of the meeting.

Jim announced that Kathy Kennedy had resigned and that the board has asked Susan Hollingsworth to fill in for the remainder of the year as Secretary and she has agreed.

Jim Jordan called on Susan Hollingsworth for the secretaries report. A motion was made for the minutes to be excepted and seconded. Minutes were approved.

Jim Read the treasures report.

Jim called on Linda Lewis for the league director's report.

Linda wished good luck to all players for the 2013 summer season. Stated that we had 48 teams – on Tuesday we have 16 silver and 11 bronze teams. On Wednesday we have 4 gold, 6 silver and 11 bronze teams.

She stated that placing teams in particular brackets is not a perfect science. The CVDA Board usually moves a team up if they win their bracket and/or win the finals. In some cases, even if that winning team's roster is exactly the same as the previous season, there are other teams added that affect the placement. Also there are some captains that manipulate their rosters in an attempt to be placed in a lower bracket.

Linda stated that over the past few seasons, the number of silver teams has increased and there have been fewer bronze teams. We would like to ask you, as seasoned players, to promote the CVDA and encourage new players to join our sport.

She reminded everyone that new players pay \$20 the first night of play and turn in an application. Former players have to pay \$30 and turn in an application.

She also welcomed back Yesterday's Tavern of Petersburg as a sponsor. Wally Jr. will be their area rep. We also have a new area rep – David Harrison.

Linda stated that we had a pretty good turn out at the Captain's meeting last week. Stated that it helps the board when Captains offer their ideas and thoughts as we begin each new season. This meeting is not mandatory but it helps cut down the time at the General Membership Meeting.

Linda wanted everyone to please take note: The max add-on sheet in the packets needs to be changed for two. Wednesday Silver teams. Changes are do to the division decided at the Captain's meeting.

Linda asked that the captains encourage their team to read the By-Laws, Rules of Play and Chalker's Etiquette. She also wanted to point out that chalkers do not talk to shooters, and they must stand as still as possible during play. Make sure the chalker has recorded your shot before you pull your darts out of the board.

Jim Called on Rodney Wilson for the Audit report

Rodney Wilson stated that the books were reviewed by the accountant and correct classifications were done on some of the entries so that the correct amounts were reflected in each account.

Jim called on Linda for the Webmaster report

Linda stated that the upcoming seasons information will be up on the website the following day.

Jim called on Susan Hollingsworth for the ADO report.
She stated that May 11th and 19th there would be CVDA 501 Qualifiers at Omega with signups at 11 and play starting at 11:30. \$11/person entry fee.

She also announced that we will be hosting the ADO Regional on June 1st at Omega with signups at 10:00am and play will begin promptly at 11am. Winner of the ADO Regional will then go on to Connecticut.

Jim Called on Susan Hollingsworth for the Youth League report
Susan stated that events are held on Sunday at Murphy's Law at 2:00. Please see website for dates since we have to work around a lot of other events. Weekend events held at Murphy's Law will have Youth/Adult events along with our Dart Classic at the Koger Center.

Terry Kelly sent motion to amend CVDA Rule.

Current Rule passed on Sept 5, 2012 going into effect last season (2013 Winter) Section 1 – Membership Item P – rounding of PPA's

Wanted to change from nearest 10th to the 2nd decimal point. Reason for this is our current rule state that new players will be given a .250 starting PPA but it conflicts with the rule passed in September as it would mean the new player actually gets a .3 PPA.

The formula used to calculate PPA's results in a two decimal number.

Discussion was held and motion was passed.

Linda Lewis presented motion

Under Membership H

Linda wanted the wording to be changed from highest team's PPA to Lowest team's PPA in their division of both nights or up to the overall division PPA caps.

Discussion was held and motion was passed

Rodney Wilson present motion regarding books

Suggested that the CVDA upgrade software from 2009 to newer version or to consider QuickBooks online, which is \$12.95/month. He suggested that Ms. Downey, the current CVDA accountant, to do the books on a monthly basis for a cost of \$80/hour. It is most likely that on a normal month it would take about ½ hour to update and reconcile account since we have very few transactions per month.

Discussion was held and motion was passed.

Amber Cole made motion

Motion to pay the top 4 men and top 4 Women point winners for the CVDA Sention points at the CVDA Dart Classic effective immediately.
